c) Play equipment

- ➤ <u>Work completed</u> on 2nd ball rebound fencing.
- ➤ <u>Skate-park ramps</u>. Contractor site visit held. Discussions on refurbishment required where showing signs of wear. Quotes received on 4 various options (attached). *Action/Resolution:* Proposed by Cllr: Pilcher, seconded by Cllr: Lake and agreed by 6 members present with 1 against, to have a complete replacement of all ramps and landing sections, as more cost-effective long-term. Approximate 9 days of work noted. Clerk to try grant application again from Rural England.
- ➤ <u>MUGA area refurbishment</u> continues; tarmac surface repaired. *Action/Resolution: Relining quotes to be obtained for marking out 5 a-side and basketball courts. Grant funding unsuccessful for this project from Rural England.*
- ➤ <u>Soft Play Surfaces Junior Play Area</u>: Following recent cleaning, condition has not improved. Document presented on procedure to clean this type of surface, to be addressed next spring.

d) <u>Highways</u>

Faults etc, as reported logged with Kent Highways for attention:

- ➤ Highway Improvement Plan (HIP)
 - Tactile paving on drop kerbs

Installation completed in Lancaster Drive. Concerns raised on other locations. *Action/Resolution: Clerk to contact Kent Highways for a site meeting.*

Double yellow lines, B2011 junctions

Road Traffic Order consultation completed. Lines to be installed when programmed.

- Re-introduction of fixed Speed Indicator Flashing Devices on B2011, between the 40mph zone East and West of village. *Action/Resolution: Traffic survey week beginning 13th June. To be discussed further when results known.*
- Change of speed limit from 40mph to 30mph. Action/Resolution: Re-visit if speed survey supports the criteria required for any change.
- Double yellow lines Capel Street at "pinch point" between Lancaster Avenue to School and pavement parking issues. Action/Resolution: Kent Highways' Design Team considered these and have not been deemed feasible, due to the restriction of parking for both residents and their visitors. In addition to this, it is not believed double yellow lines would have the desired effect as parking to load/unload for 5 minutes is allowed. As Green Lane is a bridleway and cars should not be using this, double yellow lines cannot be installed here.
- Capel Street inconsiderate parking

Action/Resolution: Suggestion made by Highways for school to contact KCC Travel Planners supporting Kent schools, to see how they can assist in alleviating the inconsiderate parking – an introduction email provided could be sent to the school.
