From the vicarage

In May 1373 a woman who we now know as Julian of Norwich lay seriously ill, and a priest was summoned. As he held a crucifix in front of her the figure of Christ seemed to speak to her, an experience which, once recovered, she described in her book *Revelations of Divine Love*. Possibly the first book in English to be written by a woman, it's still in print. Her conviction that God's love conquers all, and that come what may 'All shall be well, and all shall be well, and all manner of thing shall be well' - continues to comfort and inspire.

But could such a spiritual classic still be written today? In situations like Julian's people are now more likely to send for a paramedic, rather than a priest. Could the 'Still, Small Voice' have penetrated the flashing of blue lights, and the wail of sirens?

Rabbi Lionel Blue used to say that God shows his hand in the most unexpected places. Others talk about 'getting a prod'. I know what they mean.

Take a visit to the dentist, for example. Arriving there a couple of months ago I unexpectedly found myself being asked to add one of their work colleagues to our prayer list at church. She was ill, they were concerned about her, and they evidently thought that prayer might help. As I sat in the chair, my dentist handed me a piece of paper with her name on it. I had arrived there expecting to have a broken tooth removed, but ended up with a 'prod'!

On a return visit recently, I asked how she was. I was told that she is still receiving treatment. I told them that we're still praying. "Thanks Brian," came the reply. "It does help." ... Brian

Summary of some items discussed at meeting held Tuesday, 17th September 2024



Requests from public and Other Feedback:

- Flooding issues Capel Street/Lancaster Avenue: Section 19 report – Meetings have been arranged with Residents and Kent County Council, to discuss a draft report.
- Concerns discussed in relation to use and ownership of a section of Bridleway ER252 (Green Lane/George Close). This will be re-addressed by Councillors, when they have received all the relevant and correct information from the authorities, with time given to read that received. This will enable a way to progress forward, to keep this helpful and useful for all, as to not cause any further disruption and upset to those concerned.

Planning:

- All planning applications and comments available to view on Dover District Council website:

- Land South Cauldham Lane – Members agreed a response to application on conditions for proposed off-site works.
- Local Plan – Still waiting on Government Inspectorate.

Neighbourhood Watch: No report received.

CCTV – More signage in location discussed.

Playing Field and Equipment:

- Tightening bolts, different bolts or extra uprights to be investigated and tried, to lessen the noise of the ball rebound fencing.
- Permission to plant a memorial tree, still waiting DDC ratification.
- Trees heights on boundaries – enquiries to be made on cost of a tree survey.
- Condition of wet-pour surface to be re-addressed.

Traffic Management and Highways:

- On-site meeting with National Highway Officer, regarding lack of signage on M20/A20 for diverting traffic, still to be chased.
- Reinstatement of speed activated signs on B2011 – request on costings to be requested.
- Repairs to tactile paving – programmed for 7th October.

Public Rights of Way: Reinstatement of finger-post, ER252, New Dover Road to Beatrice Road reported.

Speed Watch: Report received from delegate Councillor noted.

- 13 Sessions held since last meeting.
- 234 Vehicles speeding, reported to Kent Police.
- Enquiries made on a Team Meeting.

Capel-le-Ferne Speed-watch Group

AN ALL-DAY EVENT WAS HELD BY OUR TEAM, FRIDAY 30TH AUGUST.

In total, 2,806 vehicles were counted passing their position, on New Dover Road (B2011), by the Bridle Path up from George Close, from 06:30hrs to 19:30hrs.

Of those, 137 were above 46mph. That's an overall percentage of 4.88%.
30% of offending vehicles were travelling at speeds over 50mph and the two fastest cars, achieved 57mph. The worst times for speeding were 06:30hrs to 07:30hrs and 19:00hrs to 19:30hrs. At least 7 of the vehicles seen, had previously been recorded speeding, at this, or other locations in the village. That includes a black Jaguar, that passed the Team at 14:42hrs, travelling at 50mph and then decided to pass again, an hour later, doing 52mph. Also, a Black Suzuki at 55mph, a Black Volkswagen at 57mph, a Black Nissan at 57mph and a Grey Nissan at 55mph were amongst other excessive speeds recorded.

Details of all 137 vehicles have been passed to Kent Police for action.

Respect to Police Officer Jason for coming out to join the team and enforce speeding motorists.
