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National Highways Meeting. 22/11/24 3.00 pm

The meeting was held with the National Highways team, Kent and Medway Resilience Forum, Hawkinge Town Council and Capel Parish Council.

The discussions revolved around how badly Capel and Hawkinge were affected when there were problems on to A20 and/or the Roundhill Tunnels.

The two main problems being TAP and the closure of the East bound tunnel.

The closure of the East bound Tunnel whether planned or otherwise, causes major problems in the surrounding area.

This is because of the lack of driver information when the tunnel is closed.

During October TAP was triggered for 20 days.

KCC carried out a traffic survey on the B2011 through Capel for a week in June.

The daily average for vehicles passing through the village was 15,400, many drivers using the B2011 to avoid TAP.

Whilst there may be warnings on gantry signs of the M20 when there are problems on the A20 Roundhill Tunnel east bound, there is a total lack of signage from J13 of the M20 onwards via the A259 (Churchill Avenue) the A260 towards Hawkinge and A20.

The main questions for the meeting were: -

- 1. When the east bound tunnel is closed due to a backup of TAP could the trucks be stopped before they reach J10 on the M20?
- 2, When the east bound tunnel is closed for other reasons, could digital signage be installed at each end of Churchill Avenue (A259) to divert traffic to the A260 and A20?

The meeting was informative and in answer to question 1, Highways do implement Brock Zero, which is designed to operate when the tunnel is closed due to TAP. Brock Zero is designed to stop the trucks before they reach the Roundhill Tunnels, but due to time lag, it's success at times, may be limited.

In answer to question 2, steps are going to be taken to ensure adequate diversionary signage is in place on the A259 and A260.

Highways will also look into the installation of more permanent signage, but this could take some time and there is no guarantee that it would happen.

Highways have installed yellow hatched lines on the roundabout at the bottom of Jubilee Way to stop trucks blocking the roundabout.

Highways will also look at the information provided to sat nav companies, to see if appropriate updates can be relayed to HGV and other commercial vehicle drivers prior to the tunnel being closed.

However, it was stated that there can always be road traffic incidents that happen where instant solutions are not readily available.
